Day 4 Cappadocia – Full Day Tour (B)

After breakfast, depart for our Cappadocia tour including; Ozkonak Underground City, Derwent (Imagination Valley) Zelve Open Air Museum, Pasabag Valley, Goreme Panorama. After lunch break, we will make a shopping tour in which you will be aware of the ancient arts of Turkey like carpet weaving, leather manufacturing and jewellery. Day 5 Cappadocia - Kayseri Fly Izmir - Kusadasi (B)

Day 6 Kusadasi – Ephesus & Sirince Full Day Tour (B)
